Matt Lundeen Bethel QB: 1994-97 Career: 6th grade teacher and head football coach at Redwood Valley (MN)

Lundeen came to Bethel after a stellar high school career at Becker High School where he played for his father, Dwight Lundeen (member of the MFCA Hall of Fame). A three-year starter at Bethel, Lundeen was a leader in the Bethel community and on the football field where he received All-MIAC honors in 1996 and 1997. He is third on Bethel's all-time passing list with 6,080 career passing yards. He also holds Bethel's single-season touchdown pass record (24) and single-game touchdown pass record (6). After graduating with a degree in elementary education, Lundeen immediately was hired as a 6th grade teacher and was charged with leading the Redwood Valley football program.
